These results will be displayed on <u>Care Compare</u> beginning in October 2022.

July 2022 Public Reporting Refresh

Data on <u>Care Compare</u> have been refreshed to reflect HCAHPS Survey scores from Q4 2020 – Q3 2021 (October 2020 – September 2021) and updated Star Ratings.

Mode Experiment

CMS published an update on the results of the 2021 HCAHPS mode experiment. Analysis is still underway, but initial results are showing favorable response rates from web-first mixed mode survey administration. The progress update is available here.

Proposed Rule

The calendar year 2023 Hospital Outpatient Prospective Payment and Ambulatory Surgical Center Payment Systems and Quality Reporting Programs Proposed Rule has been published in the <u>Federal Register</u>. The proposal does not alter the timeline included in the 2022 Final Rule mandating administration of the OAS CAHPS Survey.

Fielding the OAS CAHPS Survey will be mandatory for Hospital Outpatient Departments (HOPDs) beginning in 2024 and Ambulatory Surgery Centers (ASCs) beginning in 2025. HOPDs should target 300 completed surveys a year, and ASCs have a target of 200. If an HOPD or ASC does not meet the quality reporting requirement, they will receive a reduction of 2% in their annual fee schedule update. HOPDs or ASCs that see fewer than 60 OAS CAHPS-eligible patients a year may apply for a size exemption.

The Final Rule is expected in November 2022.


July 2022 Public Reporting Refresh

Hospice Payment Rate Update Final Rule

CMS has published the Hospice Payment Rate Update Final Rule for fiscal year 2023, which is available on the <u>Federal Register</u>. The rule finalizes the proposal for Hospice Star Ratings to be publicly reported beginning with the August 2022 refresh of Hospice data on <u>Care Compare</u>. Analysis of mode experiment results are still underway, and no changes the survey or survey administration will be made at this time. The ICH CAHPS mode experiment has received OMB approval. The experiment will be conducted during the Fall 2022 fielding and will include around 25,000 patients. For many dialysis facilities, EQRS data does not currently include patient email addresses. The full Proposed Rule is on the <u>Federal Register</u> for review, and CMS is accepting public comments <u>here</u> throughout August.




