CMS Responds to Hurricanes Fiona and Ian

In response to the public health emergencies caused by Hurricane Fiona and Hurricane Ian, CMS is granting exceptions to healthcare organizations in Puerto Rico, Florida, and South Carolina for some quality and value-based measures. Exceptions are applicable to multiple CAHPS initiatives.



2023 Final Rule

CMS published the calendar year 2023 Home Health Prospective Payment System Final Rule. The rule finalized the proposal to require Home Health Agencies (HHAs) to report all-payer Outcome and Assessment Information Set (OASIS) data beginning January 1, 2025. Information on this and other updates is included in the CMS Fact Sheet. The full rule is available on the Federal Register.

October 2022 Public Reporting Refresh



Preview Reports

Hospices can review their results that will be published on <u>Care Compare</u> in advance of the February 2023 refresh. Preview Reports are available for review through the Certification and Survey Provider Enhanced Reports (CASPER) application until December 9, 2022. 2021 Mode Experiment

CMS is reviewing results of the CAHPS Hospice mode experiment where 56 hospices participated to test a mixed mode web and mail administration, a revised version of the survey, and revised protocols including a prenotification letter and extended fielding period. More than 15,000 caregivers were sampled.

→ Mixed web/mail administration significantly improved response rates for decedents/caregivers with email addresses

Response Rates by Mode				
Mail only	35.1%			
Phone only	31.5%			
Mixed Mail/Phone	45.3%			
Web/Mail Overall	39.7%			
Caregivers With Email Addresses	49.6%			
Caregivers Without Email Addresses	35.2%			

- \rightarrow A prenotification letter increased response rates by 2.4%
- → Extending the fielding period from 42 to 49 days increased response rates by 2.5% in mail only mode
- → The revised survey in mail only mode had similar response rates to the current survey

CMS will use these results when considering potential changes to the survey. Any resulting proposals will be included in future rulemaking and available for public comment before implementation.

CAHPS for MIPS

2023 Medicare PFS Final Rule

CMS has published the calendar year 2023 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (PFS) Final Rule. Highlights include:

- → For Medicare Shared Savings Program Accountable Care Organizations (MSSP ACOs), the rule reaffirms that for performance years 2022 – 2024, organizations that do not report any of the 10 CMS Web Interface measures or any of the 3 eCQMs/MIPS CQMs and do not administer a CAHPS for MIPS Survey will not meet the quality performance standard. It adds that in PYs 2023 and 2024, ACOs that do not meet these requirements will not meet the alternative quality performance standard, which would exclude them from shared savings. If they fail to meet these requirements, ENHANCED track ACOs would automatically receive the maximum shared loss rate.
- → CMS is reviewing feedback received regarding adding questions about health disparities and price transparency and potentially creating a shortened version of the survey. This information will be considered in future rulemaking.
